

Corrigendum and clarifications from the Commission on a call for proposals for indirect RTD actions under the specific programme for research, technological development and demonstration on a user-friendly information society (1998 to 2002)
(The IST Programme)

The European Commission recently published a call for proposals for indirect RTD actions under the specific programme for research, technological development (RTD) and demonstration on a user-friendly information society (1998 to 2002) (Official Journal of the European Communities, C321 of 16.11.2001, p. 13).

1. Under Point 3 (last paragraph) the text should read: "Please note that SME specific measures (co-operative research projects) are implemented through a specific call for these measures, for which proposals can be submitted with a final reception deadline of **28 February 2002 at 5pm** (Brussels local time)¹" (instead of 17 April 2002).

2. Under Point 4 Part 1a, the following clarification should be noted: the action lines given below are only open to demonstration projects:

IST-2002-II.1.3 - Addressing eEurope and eEurope+ objectives;

IST-2002-IV.8.1 - Microelectronics design and IP re-use;

3. In addition to the information given under Part 1b of the call, the following clarification is also given: proposals for support activities are invited to be submitted by the fixed reception deadline of 21 February 2002 at 5 pm (Brussels local time) for the following action lines:

IST-2002-IV.5.1 (s) Towards technologies, systems and networks beyond 3G;

IST-2002-IV.8.1 (t+s) Microelectronics design and IP re-use;

IST-2002-IV.8.2 (t+s) Microelectronics technologies – processes, equipment and devices;

IST-2002-V.1.10 (t+s) CPA10: Sensor technologies and applications;

IST-2002-V.1.15 (s) CPA15: Technology platforms for cultural and arts creative expressions.

Please consult the Action Line descriptions in the IST 2002 Work Programme for details. The action lines marked (s) are only open to support activities, and those marked (t+s) are open for both take-up actions and support activities.

4. Finally, in the Italian version of the last IST Call for Proposals, under Point 4 Part 2a the deadline for receipt given in the first sub-paragraph was given as 14 June 2002 ("14 giugno 2002") whereas it should read **28 February 2002** ("28 febbraio 2002"). The second sub-paragraph deadline (for certain Action Line IST-2002-VI.I.I proposals only) remains 14 June 2002.
