Specific arrangements for this call

As noted in the Guide for applicants:

BEFORE SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS:

- A **pre-proposal check service** is offered by all objectives; see Annex 1 of the Guide for applicants for details. A pre-proposal check form can be downloaded from elsewhere on this call page
- A **set of evaluation forms** for you to carry out a trial evaluation of your own proposal is also available elsewhere on this call page

This call is published on in the FP7 Participant Portal and not on CORDIS. Proposers must use our new Portal Submission Service for the submission of their proposals and not the EPSS.

A requirement of our new submission system is that all partners in the proposal must have a Participant Identification Code (PIC) number. Instructions on how to obtain one are given in the Guide for applicants, on a document included in the 'Additional Documents' part of this [call](#) and on tab '[My Organisations](#)' in the [Participant Portal](#).

Failure to include PIC numbers for every partner **will block the submission of your proposal !**

AFTER SUBMISSION OF PROPOSALS:

- Project coordinators should contact the ICT information desk (ict@ec.europa.eu) if they have not received by email an **Acknowledgment of receipt** for their proposal by Monday 29th November 2012.
- **Hearings** will be offered to **IP proposals** initially reaching all evaluation thresholds, and will take place in the **week beginning Monday 3th December 2012** in **Brussels**.
- Proposal coordinators should contact the ICT information desk (ict@ec.europa.eu) if they have not received an **Evaluation Summary Report** by Friday 21th December 2012.
